

## **\$29K in Energy Efficiency Incentives Presented to St. Paul's Towers**

Under the auspices of PG&E's Healthcare Energy Efficiency Program (HEEP), Willdan Energy Solutions (WES) worked closely with St. Paul's Towers of Oakland, California to achieve annual energy savings of 17.1 kW, 239,457 kWh, and 4,100 therms. St. Paul's Towers accomplished such energy savings by installing VFDs on the domestic water pumps, rebuilding the cooling tower, and retrofiting burners on the boilers. In September 2012, WES and PG&E presented an incentive check of \$29,344.13 to St. Paul's Towers.
