Port Hueneme, CA

The Port of Hueneme Shore-Side Power (“the Project”) is ground-up construction of 1,400 linear feet of a wharf electrification system that provides shore-side power for fresh-fruit cargo vessels. In January 2014, shore-side power was required for all refrigerated cargo vessels docking in California. The Project will result in a reduction of NOx vessel emissions from 263 tons per year to 53 tons per year and PM emissions from 43 tons per year to 9 tons per year. The total wages of dock workers associated with this increase in activity will be \$20 million annually, and there will be 161 construction, manufacturing and professional service jobs created by the Project, which will also provide for the retention of nearly 3,000 produce distribution and processing jobs at the Port of Hueneme.

The Project also included the acquisition of a mobile food pantry to be operated by Food Share Inc. The mobile pantry will be used to combat the food desert conditions currently found in Ventura County.
